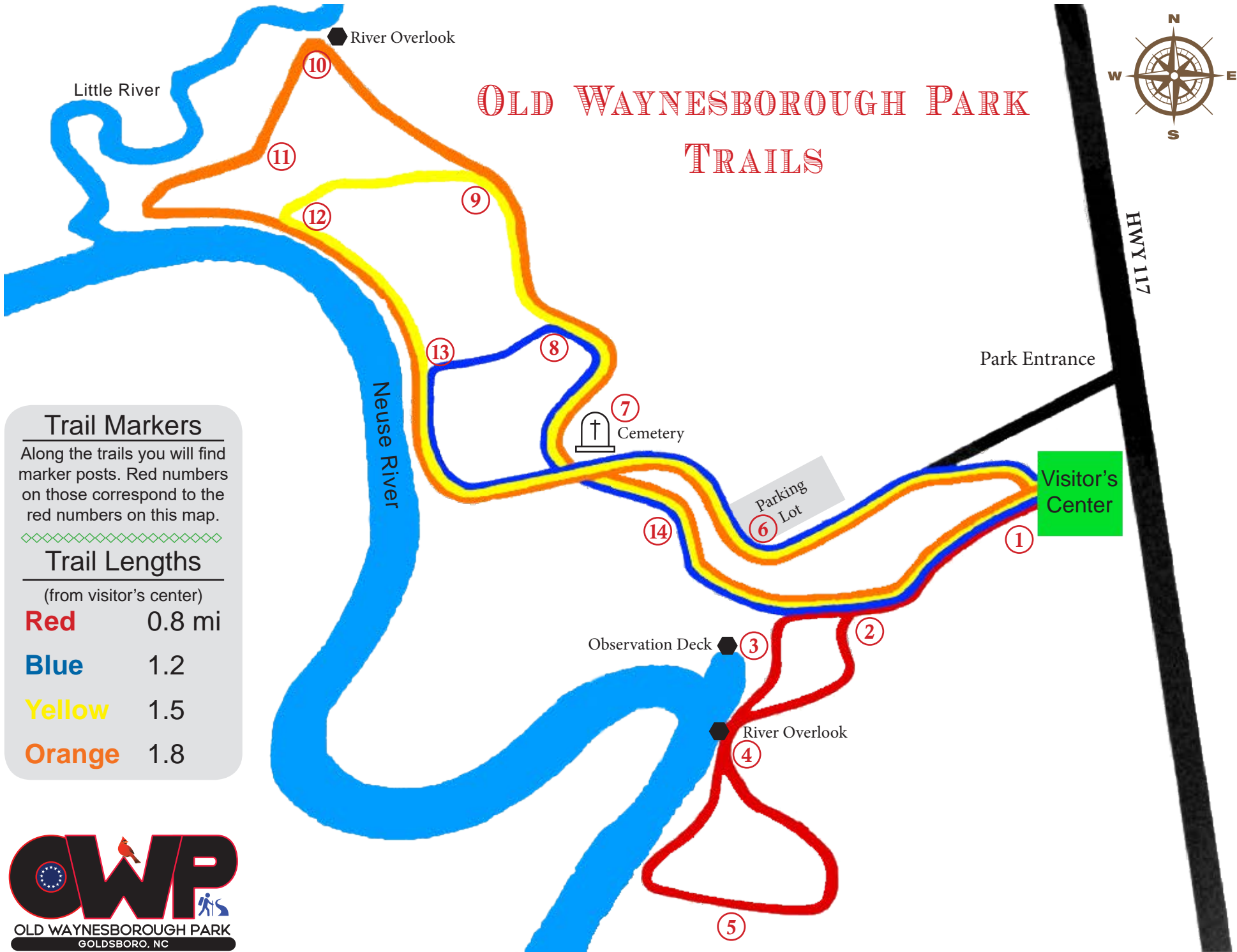


# OLD WAYNESBOROUGH PARK TRAILS

Along the trails you will find marker posts. Red numbers on those correspond to the red numbers on this map.

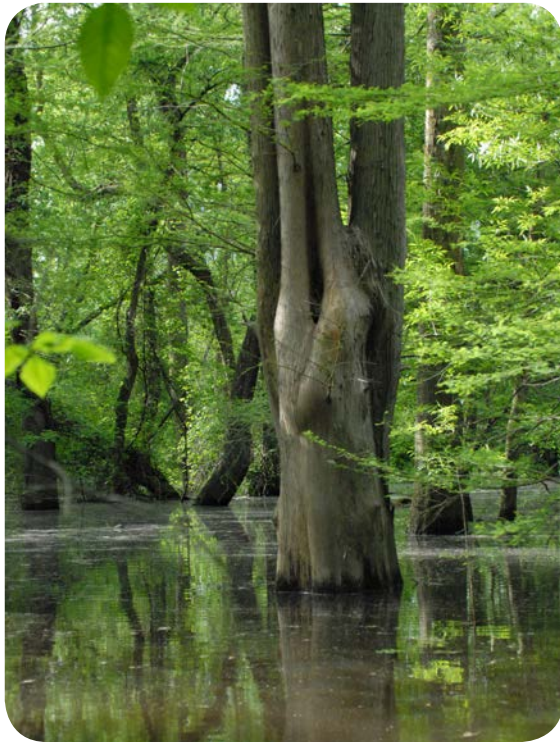


## Trail Lengths

<b>Red</b>	0.8 mi
<b>Blue</b>	1.2
<b>Yellow</b>	1.5
<b>Orange</b>	1.8





## William P. Kemp, Jr

The trails at Old Waynesborough Park are named in honor of Bill Kemp. Mr. Kemp spent his life working at his family's local furniture manufacturing plant, formerly located just a few hundred yards from the park.

Bill served as president of the Old Waynesborough Commission and spent countless hours working to improve the park. He was instrumental in the creation of the trails.
